1. **One Cadet- One Tree Campaign:-**NCC Cadets of the college participated in 'One Tree One Cadet' campaign to become part of Govt of India initiative (# एक_पेड़_एक_छात्र and #Plant4Mother) which was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister. The cadets planted trees between 10th July 2024 to 13 July 2024 and spread awareness about role of planting in halting and reversing land degradation, building drought resilience and preventing desertification. They had also uploaded the photos of plantation on <https://merilife.nic.in/>portal.

2. **Selection of Cadets for Republic Day Parade:** - Cadet Ankush and Cadet Sourabh of the NCC Sub-Unit of the college were selected on 26 July 2024 by the NCC authorities at Battalion Headquarters to undergo further camp trainings to prepare for participation in Republic Day Parade 2025 at New Delhi.

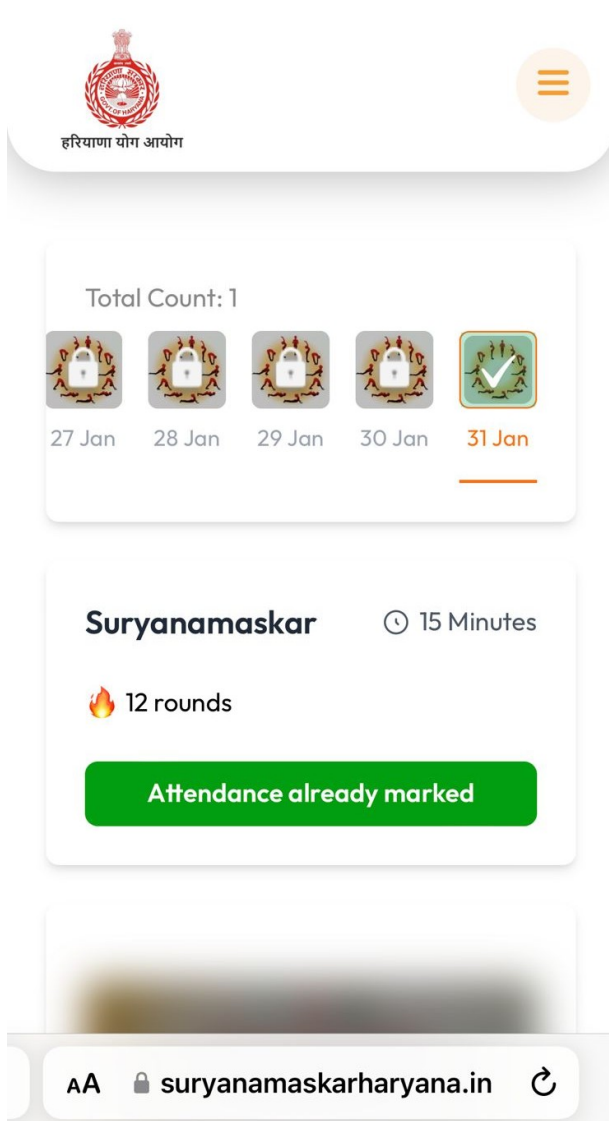

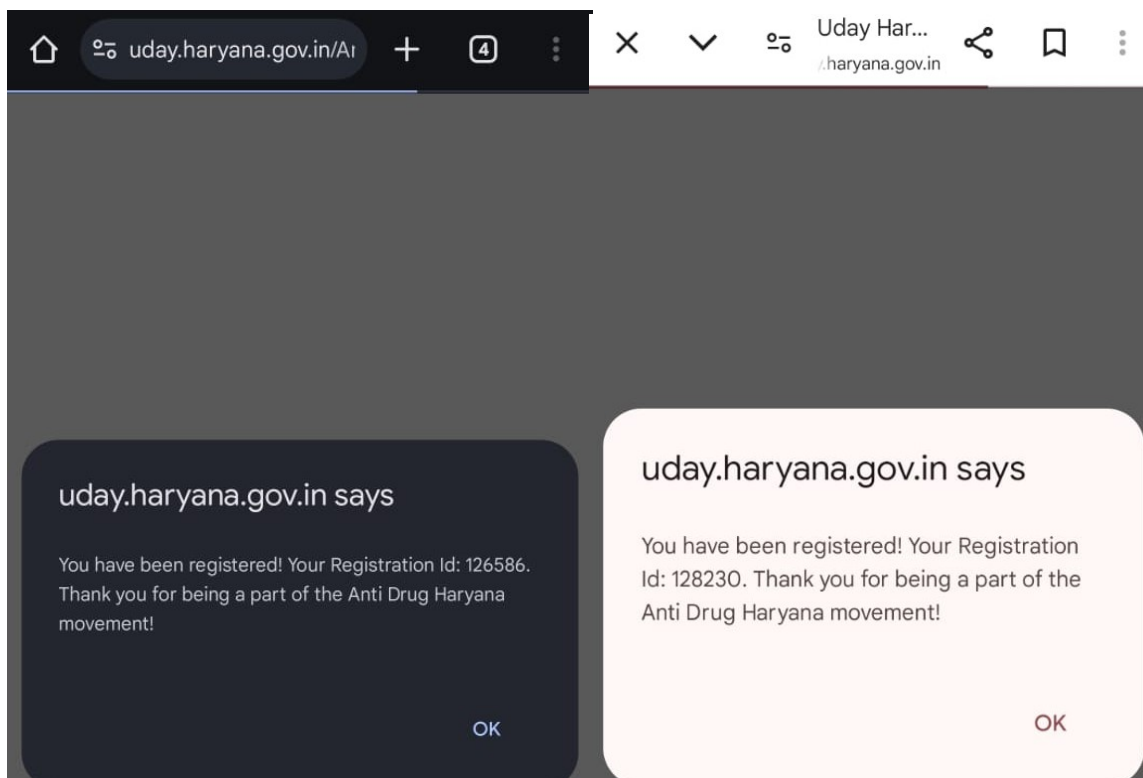

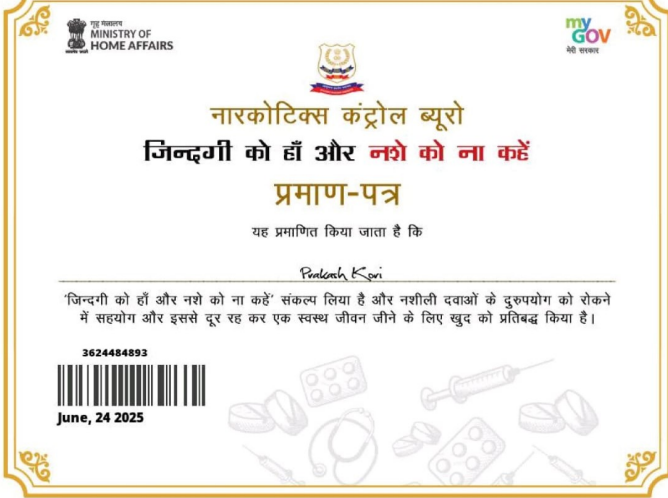
